Students with some Japanese language skills (knows hiragana/katakana and some basic Japanese sentence structures (such as ~desu, verb conjugation-e.g. taberu, tabemasu, tabemasen, tabemasenka, tabemasho) are eligible to take this course. You will learn short forms and more conjugations in this course.

Time & Day: Monday, 16:00-17:00

Venue: Kobushi Seminar Room C

Students with some Japanese language skills (such as verb conjugations and adjectives) are eligible to take this course. You will learn short forms and more conjugations in this course.

Intermediate Japanese

Time & Day: Monday, 15:00-16:00

Venue: Kobushi Seminar Room C

This course aims to develop linguistic, sociolinguistic, and strategic skills in reading, writing, listening, and speaking to prepare students to attend courses in Japanese universities.
