Fire

Heavy rain & Typhoon

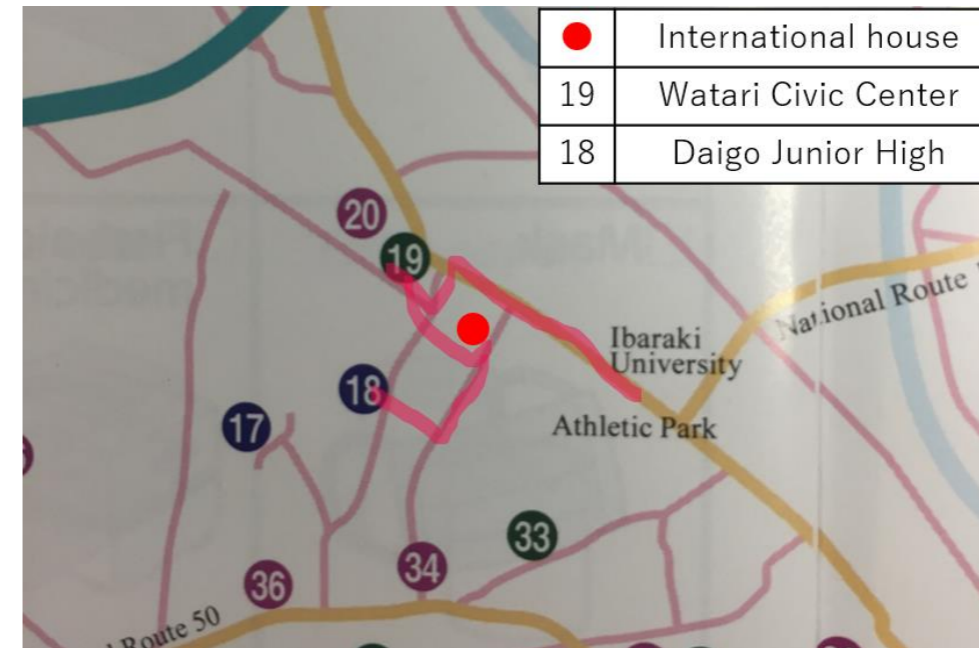
- Refrain from going outside
